

# DR. JANE SCOTT, MD

Author of “The Confident Parent”

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Born in Mombasa, Kenya, Dr. Jane Scott attended the University of Western Australia Medical School in Perth at the age of 16. She subsequently lived in the Australian outback, England, Ireland, and the South African desert. Years later after moving to the United States, she attended the University of Colorado Medical School and completed her residency in pediatrics and fellowship in neonatology at Duke University while simultaneously raising four young children. After serving as a staff neonatologist at St. Joseph’s Hospital in Denver for six years, she led the effort to transition St. Luke’s Magic Valley Hospital NICU in Twin Falls, Idaho—the only NICU within a 120-mile radius—from a Level 1 unit to a Level 3A unit capable of treating many of the area’s smallest, sickest newborns.

Dr. Jane returned to Colorado in 2011 and practiced urgent care pediatrics in Centennial until December 2014. She is the inventor of the [Turtle](#), an FDA-cleared infant repositioning device designed to prevent and eliminate flat head syndrome, and is the founder of Turtle Products, LLC, which sells and distributes the Turtle as well as other products to help hospitalized infants with optimal head positioning. The Turtle has been adopted by pediatrics departments and NICUs in more than 80 hospitals around the world, and Dr. Jane’s medical device products are being researched by university and hospital NICUs and outpatient clinics, including Duke University and Newman University in Pennsylvania. “The Confident Parent” is her first book.
